DOMINICAN REPUBLIC AFTER HURRICANE NOEL

The people of the Dominican Republic did not receive fair warning about Tropical Storm Noel. On October 28, 2007 the storm was stated to be 150 miles southeast of Port-au-Prince Haiti, on the Island of Hispaniola. Due to its north/northwest trajectory, the government of the Dominican Republic did not warn it's people because of meteorological inconsistencies with the formation of the unclear storm. Warning of this Tropical Storm was finally given only 6 hours before it made landfall in the neighboring country of Haiti on October 29, 2007.

Hispaniola, the largest island in the Caribbean, with its large mountain ranges, could not protect the Dominican Republic from Noel's 60 mph (95 km/h) winds and devastating rains. Heavy amounts of rain fell across Hispaniola for five days with flooding all over the island, especially the western region of the Dominican Republic. The highest amount of flooding was at Padre Las Casa which was 550 mm/ 21.65 inches, reaching chest high.

Many of the locals I spoke with told me it was like a thief in the night. Tropical

Storm Noel took entire villages, homes and complete families in the middle of the night. The current was so strong it created new rivers, wiped out crops, and sent everything it destroyed and collected into the Caribbean Ocean. It was stated at least 100 lives were lost just in the Dominican Republic and more have been declared missing.

Three days later on Nov. 2 Tropical Storm Noel was classified as a Category I hurricane, the sixth hurricane of the 2007 season. It took 151 lives within the effected areas.

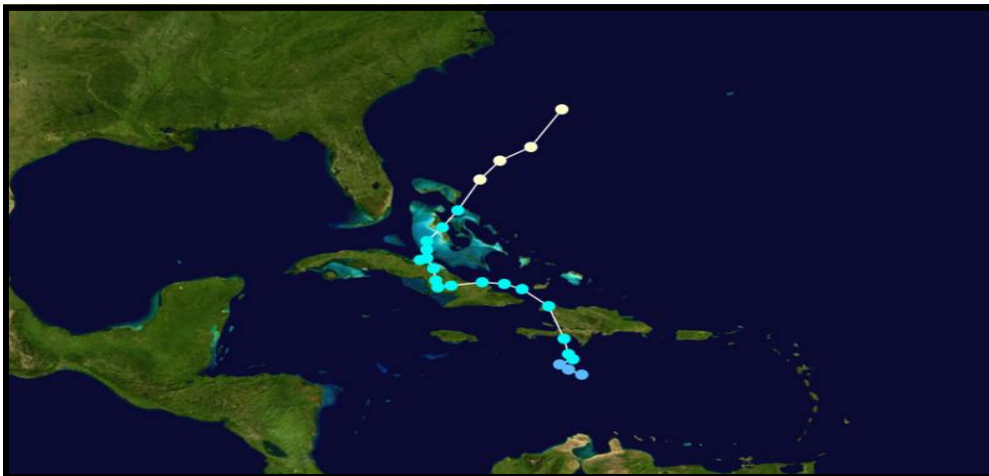

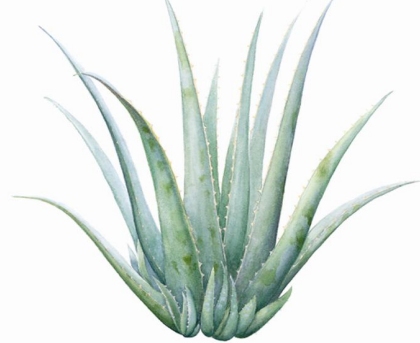
